

**Title: Incidents of violent behaviour in the modern Greek public primary school:
Investigation of differentiation parameters in the context of pupil's personal profile.**

Pupils' violent behaviour is a critical issue that affects Greek public primary schools, disturbing greatly the members of the school community. The main objective of the current study is the investigation of children's personal profile-who either have the role of the victim or the role of the offender, participating in incidents of school violence, taking place in public primary schools of Attica. More specifically, the study will focus on the factors that differentiate pupil's personal profile, such as gender, age, disability, family and social status, psychological problems, learning disabilities, academic performance and national characteristics. Furthermore, the study will try to highlight -through the above characteristics, the key-factors influencing the manifestation of violent behaviour or of victimization. For the above reason an appropriate questionnaire will be developed and distributed at various schools of Attica. Finally, the analysis of the specific factors will lead to a better understanding and an effective handling of the phenomenon.
