Eleni Stamatopoulou is a PhD candidate in the Department of Biomedical Sciences of the School of Health and Welfare Sciences of the University of West Attica. Having many years of experience in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), she worked with the Central Administration of the Ministry of Health in the Hellenic Center for Disease Control & Prevention (HCDCP), in the Department of Epidemiological Surveillance and Intervention, monitoring infectious diseases and ensuring the implementation of Public Health measures, following the clinical course (Follow up) of patients admitted to the ICU. Served in the Hellenic Center for Disease Control & Prevention, she was assigned to Primary Health Care at the "Peristeri" Health Center, implementing training programs and research on preventive medicine as well as training asthmatic patients with the "Asthma School" activity.
